

THE STORY

Leni Riefenstahl is considered one of the most controversial women of the 20th century. Her films Triumph of the Will and Olympia stand for perfectly staged body worship and the celebration of the superior and victorious. At the same time, these images project contempt for the imperfect and weak. Riefenstahl's aesthetics are more present than ever today - but is that also true for their implied message? The film examines this question using documents from Riefenstahl's estate, including private films, photos, recordings and letters. It uncovers fragments of her biography and places them in an extended historical context. How could Riefenstahl become the Reich's preeminent filmmaker and keep denying any closer ties to Hitler and Goebbels? In personal documents, she mourns her "murdered ideals". Riefenstahl represents many postwar Germans who, in letters and recorded telephone calls from her estate, dream of an organizing hand that will finally clean up the "shit-hole state". Then, her work would also experience a renaissance, in a generation or two this time could come what if they are right?

THE DIRECTOR

Her novel, "Il Mio Posto È Qui," was published by Sperling & Kupfer, and its film adaptation is her debut as a director, together with her life partner Cristiano Bortone.

Cristiano Bortone, a graduate of USC and NYU, is the director of the acclaimed drama Red Like The Sky (2005) - winner of a David di Donatello Italian Film Award and awards at more than 25 other international festivals - and *Coffee* (2016), the first official co-production between Italy and China, which premiered as a special event at the Venice Days and was nominated for the China Media Awards. He is also a successful and award-winning producer (Maria, Ihm Schmeckt's Nicht!, Marina, The Italian Recipe).

DIRECTORS' NOTE

The story of *Il mio posto è qui* takes place in the aftermath of World War II. It is a historical moment in which Europe experiences, in a relatively short period of time, enormous social, cultural and political changes. The film recalls this fundamental page of history from a unique and original point of view: that of a single mother in a remote village. Although the film is set in Calabria in the mid-40s, some of its themes remain very up to date. Almost every day we read about cases of feminicide or acts of intolerance. The debate opened by the #MeToo movement has brought to light the issue once more. These topics, which by now should already be assimilated in modern society, are in fact recently even being challenged by new conservative movements making their way through Europe and around the world. With this story, we want to contribute to the reflection of these themes, through emotions and memorable characters.

THE DIRECTOR

Born in Gera, Germany in 1963, Andreas Dresen studied directing at the Konrad Wolf Film University of Babelsberg. His film *Grill Point* was a worldwide success and won awards including the Silver Bear at the 2002 Berlinale. *Cloud 9* (2008), an improvised drama about love and sexuality in older age, won several prizes including the Coup de Coeur jury prize in the 'Un Certain Regard' section at the Cannes Film Festival and the German Film Award Bronze Best Film. In 2011 *Stopped on Track* won the 'Un Certain Regard' Award at the Cannes Film Festival. In 2019, *Gundermann* won six German Film Awards, including Best Film. *Rabiye Kurnaz Vs. George W. Bush*, his fourth film in the Berlinale Competition 2022, won the Silver Bear for Best Leading Performance and the Silver Bear for Best Screenplay, as well as three German Film Awards.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

No, no more well-lit resistance drama immersed in sepia, no equipment and costume battle, no orchestral music, no enraptured and enrapturing reconstruction of history. no historicizing distance. The story of Hilde and Hans is touching, precisely because it seems so tangible and normal. The two are very young, filled with a longing for love and, yes, normality. Only times are not like that. Hilde does not join the resistance because of a political mission, but out of decency. She intuitively does what seems right to her. Giving the parents of the missing soldiers news of their survival or helping to transport a radio - that's necessary and normal right now, isn't it? Because of their great love, the two sometimes forget the danger. It's a story of love and death. It starts in the middle, going forward to the abyss and backward to happiness. In the end there is the hope and beauty of a beginning love that extends to the present, because Hans, the little son of the two, luckily survived these dark times. It's been so long. So short.



THE STORY

Radiant neurologist Katerina and Yannis, a former well-respected doctor, are heading off to a deserted seaside resort. Silence spreads in the car as they travel across sandy dunes in a windy autumn, matching the lessthan-pleasant occasion: Yannis had been called to identify the victim of a tragic accident at the hospital of the small town. When the local policeman informs them that the victim's vehicle had plunged over the parapet of a stone bridge and leads them to the morgue, Katerina sees her worst suspicions confirmed. In mythology, Arcadia is referred to as a lost world of idyllic bliss, serving as a cautionary reminder of the transitory nature of life. It is a kind of magical realm, just like the local otherworldly tavern Arcadia in the film, where time seems to have stopped.

Arcadia deals with the riskier shores of human loss, ventures into a strange sexual territory and proposes an unusual dimension of the afterlife as the captured memories of the living. Eventually the boundaries between the material and spiritual world become blurred and no one can easily tell the difference.
